



Limestone Bands Scrip Gift Cards



Scrip is a great way to raise money to pay your band fees and other expenses while you do the things that you normally do anyway: buying groceries, eating out, shopping, going to a movie, giving gifts, et cetera.

How it works: You purchase gift cards from hundreds of national retailers at face value. But by buying the cards through Scrip, you get at 1-13% rebate that goes into your student's band account. You can order traditional plastic gift cards (some of which are reloadable) to be delivered via the mail. Or you can order ScripNow® electronic cards. You can print the e-card, you can manually enter the e-card's code at checkout, or some retailers can even scan it from your smartphone.

Signing up: First, contact the Band Booster Treasurer (Treasurer@LimestoneBands.com) for the Enrollment Code. Then...

- On shopwithscrip.com, click the Register button.
- Follow the instructions to create a username and password.
- Enter your student's name. (They say that this is optional, but we need it to properly credit your student's account.)
- Enter the Enrollment Code.
- Set up the **PrestoPay** account and create your PIN.
- Follow the instructions to verify your bank account information. (This may take a day or two.)

Ordering: When you are finished signing up...

- Return to the Scrip website (shopwithscrip.com) to order gift cards.
- The rebate percentage (which varies by vendor) is shown on the website before you order. If you are ordering a physical card, the website will also tell you if the card is reloadable.
- Orders for traditional plastic cards are gathered up a couple times a year or when there is a large request for them. (This keeps down the shipping expense.) The plastic gift cards will be mailed as a bundle to the band. You can pick them up from the Treasurer at most band events.
- The rebate amount will be processed by Scrip and put into your student's band account by the Band Booster Treasurers (usually within a couple of weeks).
- Reminder on physical cards: If they go more than six months with a zero balance, they become inactive. You will have to get a whole new card.

Mobile: You can use MyScripWallet.com with your smartphone's browser (Android Chrome or Apple Safari) to purchase some electronic gift cards. You can find savings while you are waiting in line or when deciding where to eat out. Log in with your ShopWithScrip username and password. Participating retailers can scan the barcode from your phone or manually enter the barcode.
