Director's Report:

- Friday April 25, 2014 is the ISU band festival for Wind Ensemble at the Center for Performing Arts. The students should be at LCHS at 6:15am, the bus will leave at 6:30. Performance time is 9am and kids will return to LCHS approx. 11am.
- Wind Ensemble auditions for the incoming freshman will be on May 12th, if the student is accepted their schedules will be adjusted.
- The band has grown from 60 in 2006 and 104 in 2013.

The treasurer's report was reviewed by Angie Perry.

- A total of 59 students owe \$18,999.39 to the band.
- She noted several opportunities for fund raising including the Kroger card and Scrip.
- Kroger rebates this month totaled \$309.30 which went directly into the student's account.
- Scrip total for this month came to \$226.22, this is a split 50/50.
- Bartonville Christian Church took up an offering after the Jazz band performance and donated it back to the band totaling \$270.
- The uniform debt has been paid!

Time will be announced when all participating schools are registered.

Uniform prep will be Wed April 23rd in the auditorium from 6 until finished. Volunteers are needed to help.

Band Camp: Angie Becker will be overseeing snacks and drinks for camp, she would like to request volunteers to provide these items and also for people to assist at camp. She will be collecting names and phone #'s and will contact people closer to the time of camp with needs. Camp starts at 8am and kids are expected to be on the field ready at 8.
