Field Account: for field competition

Band Fees owed by students: \$6325.00

Contingency fund: A little over \$2,000 (assist with students in need)

Signing up: First, contact the Band Booster Treasurer (Treasurer@LimestoneBands.com) for the Enrollment Code. Then... • On shopwithscrip.com, click the Register button. • Follow the instructions to create a username and password. • Enter your student's name. (They say that this is optional, but we need it to properly credit your student's account.) • Enter the Enrollment Code. • Set up the PrestoPay account and create your PIN. • Follow the instructions to verify your bank account information. (This may take a day or two.)

Register your Kroger Plus card at Kroger.com. Remember: purchases will not count towards the reward until the card is registered! • Click "Sign In" (or "Register" if you do not have an account yet). • Under your account settings, under "Plus Card", click "Add Card". Enter your Kroger Plus card number and any other required information, and click "Save". This links your Plus Card with your online account. Link your account to the band program. • Under Community >> Community Rewards, click "Enroll". • Provide the required information and click Save. • Search for the LIMESTONE SCHOOL DIST 310 BAND BOOSTERS organization, select it from the list, and click "Enroll". • Verify that the enrollment information is displayed under your Account Summary. (It may take a little while for it to show up.)
