## **Director's Report**

- Limestone area Grade School Fest went very well. Great job to Mrs. Rzeszutko for coordinating. Rehearsals went very smooth during the day. Guest conductor was very impressed.
- Prop building is underway for 2023 Marching Show. Current estimate if the Boosters is going to buy the props pre-constructed is \$3600. Current estimate for prop parents to build is approximately \$1000. Would prefer to have prop parents build if possible.
- IHSA Organizational Contest will be on Thursday, 4/14 Wind Ensemble only leave school at 1:00 pm, performance is at 2:35, and will return back to LCHS around 4 pm.
- There will be a Central Illinois Jazz Society Performance at the Trailside Events Center Jazz 1 to perform on Sunday, April 16. Schedule is changed because the house band will not be playing. LCHS Jazz 1 students and Bradley jazz students to arrive around 5:30 pm. LCHS is responsible to bring their own stands and fronts. Down beat will be at 6:00 pm if everyone is on time. Bradley Jazz Band will play after LCHS Jazz 1 Band. Students will stay to help Bradley tear down after the concert. Cost is \$12 per person for patrons. Cost is free for students and members of the Central Illinois Jazz Society.
- ISU Concert Band Festival Saturday, 4/29 Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble to attend. Will ask that students arrive at approximately 1115 and plan to leave LCHS at 1130; see itinerary. Students are to eat lunch ahead of time as there will be no meal stops. There will be 3 school buses to transport students. No trailer will be needed.

- 5/3 Kiwanis Banquet for Limestone feeder school 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Honor Students Jazz 1 only will perform at the banquet from 6:00 pm to around 6:30 pm.

- LCHS Bands Spring Concert, Thursday, 5/4 will most likely be held in the main gym, but will use the auditorium if the stage lights are fixed.
- Friday, 5/5 And all that Jazz tickets go on sale tomorrow, Tuesday, April 11<sup>th</sup> in the LCHS cafeteria or by scheduling with Ms. Adriana Bryan; ticket sales end 5/1 for food purposes.
- Jazz I and II will both perform at And All That Jazz.
- 2023 Season Marching Band Kick Off is Wednesday, 5/24/23 from 6:00-7:30 pm. Will include warm ups, down time for students to get to know each other, and a little marching. Hoping this will help incoming freshmen get a feel for marching band.
- New Marching Member/New Band Parent meeting will be held Monday, 5/8/23. There will be an open house in the Band Room from 6:30-7:00 pm and the meeting will start promptly at 7:00 pm in the cafeteria. Drumline will perform as students and parents are walking up to the building.
