- 8. We will have name tags for you. Please use them for every rehearsal except the one with Bainter (I know who you are...).
- 9. Directors and chaperones will help guide you on the trip. Your parents are welcome to come, but they should not plan to follow you for the day or sit in on rehearsals. They can meet you for lunch, dinner, and at concerts, but **we have not provided food or entry** for any non-chaperone family members!
