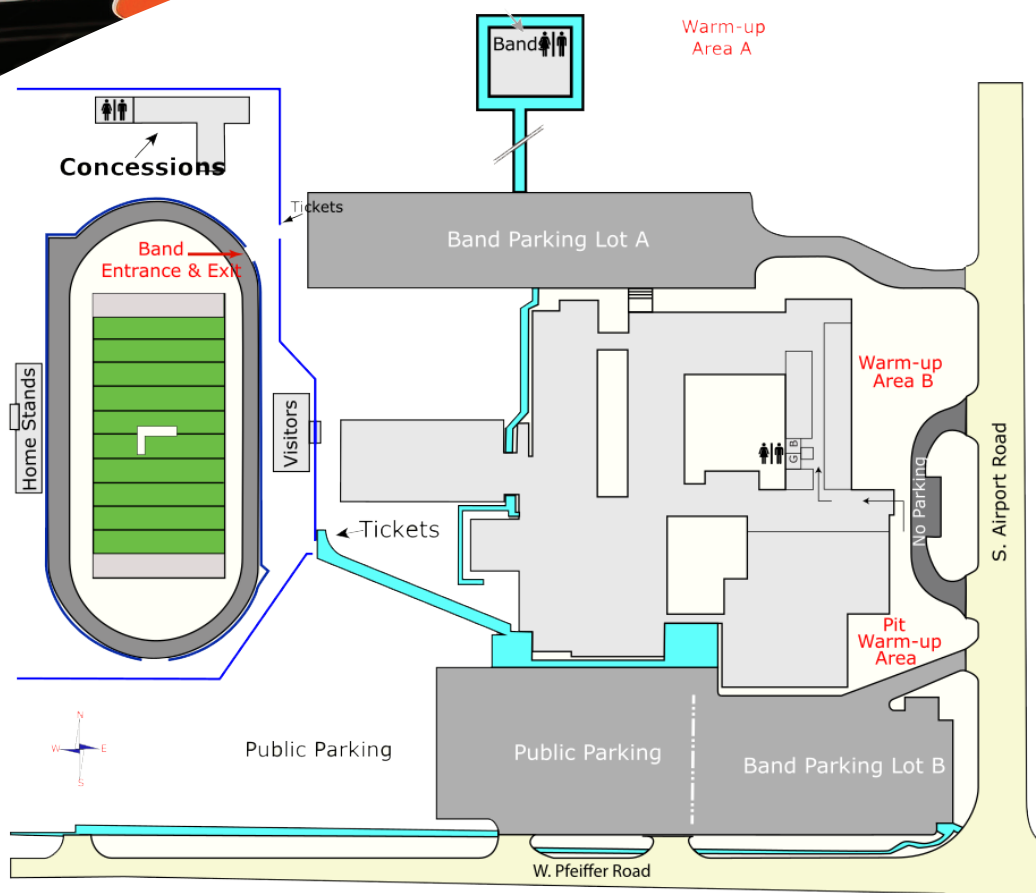

HOW THE BANDS ARE SCORED

Each band's placement score is based on a 100-point scale and is made up of six judging categories. Two judges focus on music only: an Ensemble Music judge watches the show from the press box and assesses the musical performance as a whole, while an Individual Music judge moves around the field and listens to the individual performers. These two judges' scores are averaged to make up twenty percent of the total performance score.

Two other judges perform similar roles in assessing the band's visual performance: an Ensemble Visual judge views the forms and the "big picture" from the press box, while an Individual Visual judge watches performers' feet, body carriage, and general marching technique on the field. The visual judges' scores, like the music judges', are averaged together and account for another twenty percent of the total score.

Three judges evaluate the total effectiveness of both the performance and the design of the field show: two Music General Effect and one Visual General Effect all view the performance from the press box, and each judge's score counts for twenty percent of the total. Using this system, each band receives a score that reflects all aspects of its performance and design.

Two additional judges will evaluate each band's percussion section and color guard. These rankings do not contribute to the bands' total scores and overall placements; they are used only to determine the Percussion and Auxiliary caption awards in each class.

JUDGE'S BIOS

KYLE ADELMANN: Mr. Adelman is currently one of the band directors at Minooka Community High School in Minooka, IL. His wife Christine is also a band director (Gompers Jr. High) and they have two children, Thomas and Louise. Mr. Adelman has had a long career marching drum corps as well as teaching and adjudicating marching bands across the state of Illinois.

CHRISTOPHER BUTI: Christopher Buti has directed award winning Marching Band and Color Guard programs at Grant Community High School for 9 years and Rolling Meadows High School for 24 years. Currently he is the Assistant Band Director at Maine South High School and coaches Color Guard at Buffalo Grove and Elk Grove High Schools. In addition, he has been presenting "Color Guard 101 for Future Band Directors" to future music educators across Illinois.

JEFF FIEDLER: Jeff Fiedler has been involved with high school marching band, winter color guard and drum corps since the early 1970's. First, as a member of The Cavaliers, while also participating in his own high school's marching band program in the fall. He maintained his continuous involvement with The Cavaliers for 34 years while teaching and adjudicating high school marching bands and winter color guards. He later spent 8 years with the Santa Clara Vanguard Drum & Bugle Corps in California. Fiedler's high school band instructional history includes 26 years of working with the Prospect High School band program. He has also instructed with Marian Catholic HS, Plymouth-Canton HS (MI), Lincoln-Way HS and the Westfield HS (TX) programs. He has either judged or presented visual and performance clinics for high school band and color guard programs throughout the United States, Japan, Taiwan and the Netherlands.

JOHN LARSON: John Larson has been involved in the Marching Arts in the Midwest since 1979 and serves as a music and percussion caption adjudicator across the Midwest. He has led championship drumlines at numerous high schools including Lincoln-Way Community High School, IVC High School, University High School, Galesburg High School and Normal Community High School.

CHRIST PITLIK: Christopher Pitlik was the Director of Bands at Alan B. Shepard High School in Palos Heights for 33 years. Under his direction, the Marching Astros competed extensively throughout Illinois and received numerous awards and recognitions throughout the years. On the national stage, the Marching Astros have participated in parades at the Peach Bowl in Atlanta, Georgia, the Thanksgiving Day Parade in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and as the featured parade band at Walt Disney World Resort.



JUDGES BIOS

ALLAN RENDAK: Allan Rendak has been teaching band in the Chicagoland area for 18 years and is currently the Director of Bands at Willowbrook High School in Villa Park, Illinois. Allan received his bachelor's degree from Illinois State University in 2007 and completed his Masters in Music Education at VanderCook College of Music in 2012. Allan's visual experience started when he marched with the Blue Stars Drum and Bugle Corp in 2002 and 2003. Building upon his experience, Allan began working with multiple marching bands throughout the Chicagoland area including visual instruction and drill writing. Allan currently lives in the City of Chicago with his Husband of two years.

JOHN SIERKOWSKI: John Sierakowski serves as Associate Director of Bands at West Aurora High School. He earned a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Illinois State University and a Master of Music in Education from Northern Illinois University. Mr. Sierakowski has taught both middle school and high school band programs in Illinois and maintains an active career as a marching band drill designer for numerous schools throughout the Chicago suburbs. His visual designs have been recognized at the state level and at numerous Bands of America Regional Championships. In addition, he adjudicates marching and concert festivals throughout Illinois.

BENNIE WADLINGTON: Now in his fourth season with Kinetic Independent, Bennie serves as lead designer and show coordinator, blending creative vision with strategic planning. He is also a respected adjudicator, actively judging color guard and general effect for the Midwest Color Guard Circuit, Carolina Winter Ensemble Association (CWEA), Winter Guard Association of Southern California (WGASC), Michigan Color Guard Circuit and the Wisconsin State Marching Band Association. His multi-circuit involvement reflects a strong commitment to fostering excellence and consistency across diverse programs and regions.

JORDAN YI: Jordan Yi is a band director at Metea Valley High School where he directs the marching band, jazz orchestra, Korean percussion ensemble, mariachi, and co-directs pep band. Yi is an active adjudicator and clinician for marching and concert festivals and has been involved in the marching arts through drum corps, indoor winds, and marching design. Jordan resides in Oswego, IL with his wife and two children.

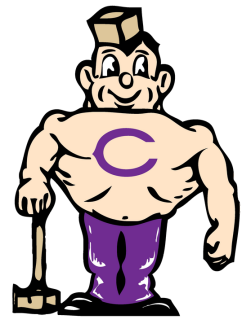

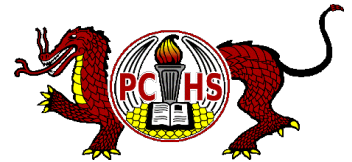
